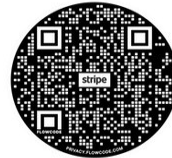

You Will Be My People: A Liturgy of Covenant and Communion

Invitation

Leader: Jesus invites *everyone* to the table...So come, let's celebrate the love that draws us here.

People: **Thanks be to God!**

Confession, Pardon and Peace

Leader: Though we are made in the image of God...

...Let us bow our heads before our God and ask for forgiveness.

People: **Forgive us, O Lord.**

Leader: Friends, though we have turned away from God, God has *never* turned away from us. We rejoice in the forgiveness we each receive in this very moment.

People: **I praise and thank you, for you are my God, who never leaves me or forsakes me, who has restored me and welcomed me home. I commit to set my heart on you, right here, right now. I turn my life over to you that I may be wholly yours.**

Leader: Our confession and pardon are not complete until we also ask forgiveness of each other and offer restoration to each other.

People: **To all I have harmed, I ask forgiveness. To all I have rejected, I welcome back. To all to whom I have harbored ill will, I extend peace.**

The Great Thanksgiving

Leader: You, our God, out of a love that could not be contained...

...In sending Jesus, you were preparing the greatest act of love the world would ever witness.

People: **Thanks be to you, O God!**

Leader: Jesus is the very fullness of God...the only thing that can ever conquer hate.

The Institution of the Lord's Supper

Leader: On the night in which he allowed himself to be handed over...

...And so as we celebrate God's goodness today, we remember the *words* of our Savior, the *acts* of our Savior, and the *love* that compelled him to give himself for our sakes, once for all.

People: **Dying, you destroyed our death. Rising, you restored our life. Lord Jesus, come in glory!**

Invocation of the Holy Spirit and our life in Christ

Breaking the Bread and Lifting the Cup

Prayer after receiving

Leader: Holy God, we are wholly yours. We rejoice in your love. We pray that we may see all your people as *you* see them and *love* them as *you* love them. Though our formal time of celebration is drawing to a close, our never-ending time of communion now begins.

People: **We go out from this place in the strength of your Spirit, to give ourselves for others, and also to receive your gifts from them, in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.**
